## Solidarity in the society

### Description of the problem

Solidarity is perceived as a value itself and as a function of every society. It means acting for the sake of all members of the society, beyond particular interests of its individual members. What is based on solidarity is for example the social insurance system, health care, or global climate protection. As a value it means building common good for all - no matter origin, status, ethnicity etc. In a narrow meaning it is also helping each other in difficult situations, caring for the least fortunate.

Think about:

- Who should be solidar with whom?
- On what level there should be solidarity (private, family, clan, state, Europe, the world)?
- What are other dimensions of solidarity (e.g. climate, human rights, social rights)?

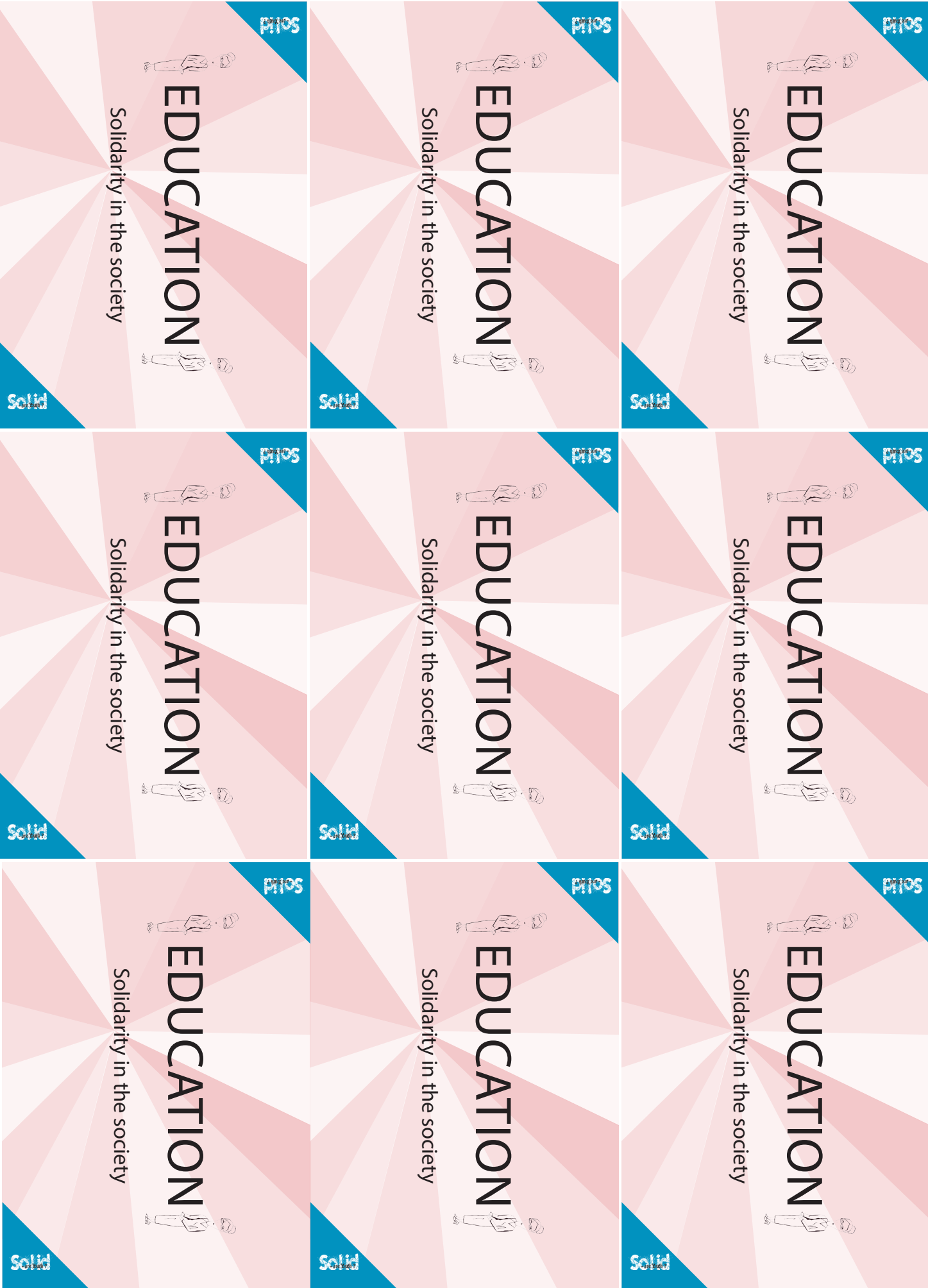

The concept of solidarity has negative and positive aspects. Negative as protection from domination of stronger parties and positive as joint effort and engagement to maintain a common good belonging to everybody.

The concept of solidarity in a social or insurance systems is close to the concept of justice. States basing on solidarity rule accumulate public resources in order to realise social justice by redistribution along agreed rules. The level of participation is gradual, depending on financial conditions.

One of the examples of implementation of solidarity rule on EU level are the EU budgetary rules - contribution to the common budget proportionate to the state's GDP.

EU realises the solidarity rule understood as "helping out less fortunate" by allocating special funds to least developed regions of the EU in order to boost their economies along agreed plan.

The solidarity rule in social insurance systems is realized along certain shifts: time (people paying shares will get it back during their retirement), intergenerational (people working now pays for retirements of current elderly), interinstitutional (one institution serves for collection to the other institutions creating a centralised system).
